

Leading the Way: Be Respectful, Responsible, Safe, and Kind Poster Contest 2023 Poster Contest Grades 4 & 5

RULES AND CRITERIA

PURPOSE

The PBIS poster contest will give Fountain Hills Middle School students (4th and 5th grade) the opportunity to create a social message that depicts leading the way in life by being respectful, responsible, safe, and kind.

WHAT IS PBIS? PBIS stands for Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports. It is a proactive approach to establishing behavioral supports and social culture that can help transform how students perform in schools and classrooms. As many parents and guardians know, Fountain Hills Middle School implemented this program several years ago. A PBIS store was created this year where students can earn points daily for positive behaviors and then are able to shop in the store using those points. The Middle School has partnered with The Fountain Hills Protect Our Youth Coalition to help move and reward the PBIS messaging forward. "Leading the Way: Be Respectful, Responsible, Safe, and Kind" is this year's theme. Remember students, surround yourself with others who encourage you to be your best!

PARTICIPATION

Contest begins Thursday, March 23, 2023. **All artwork must be submitted to the front office by 3:15pm on Friday, April 21, 2023.** Grand prize winners (1st through 3rd Place) within each grade, will be announced in May.

ARTWORK REQUIREMENTS

- Artwork must be created on the back of the provided 11"x 17" entry form or printed and firmly attached (spray mount, glue, etc.) if created digitally. Submission forms can be acquired from the front office or from the student's Academic Strategies teacher.
- At least one of the words (Respectful, Responsible, Safe, or Kind) must be used in the poster
- Posters can be a collage, drawing, painting, multi-medium, photography, marker, watercolor, colored pencil, charcoal or chalk (please coat to prevent smearing), or any digital medium
- Only individual entries will be accepted. No group entries. One entry per person.

STIPULATION

Upon submission, all submissions will be kept until the announcement of winners and will be returned back to the student. However, the winning posters can be reproduced and/or distributed in the future for purposes related to the Fountain Hills Protect Our Youth Coalition.

JUDGING

The Fountain Hills Protect Our Youth Coalition will select judges and it will be their sole and unlimited discretion to select the submission they believe best represents living Above the Influence. **Criteria for judging will use a 10-point scale:**

- Theme Relevance
- Originality/Creativity
- Visual Effect (layout/space usage/color harmony)
- Content Impact/Presentation

CONTEST PRIZES

1st Place: Choice of PBIS Store Bike or Skateboard and Winner's poster will be made into Papa Murphy's pizza topper

2nd Place: 500 PBIS Points

3rd Place: 250PBIS Points
